This is in response to your letter dated May 12, 2010, regarding your belief that Inspector General Glenn Fine, U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), undermined the integrity of his office by his "repeated failure to review the questionable dismissal of *U.S. v. New Black Panther Party...*". You also note that you have urged Mr. Fine to open an investigation into whether improper political influence contributed to the dismissal of the above case, and that he has not taken any action.

In accord with the Inspector General Act of 2008, as amended, we have referred this matter to the Integrity Committee for appropriate action.
